## THE BANGLADESH (COMPTROLLER AND AUDITOR-GENERAL) ORDER, 1972

Whereas it is expedient to provide for appointment of a Comptroller and ditor-General of Bangladesh;

Now, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of Independence of in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased make the following

- 1. (1) This Order may be called the Bangladesh (Comptroller and Auditoreral) Order, 1972.
- (2) It extends to the whole of Bangladesh.
- 3) It shall come into force at once.

  - (b) occupy and other position carrying the right to remuneration to rendering of services,

- (2) A person who has held office as Comptroller and Auditor-General not be eligible for further appointment in the service of Bangladesh.
